

Announcing the Canada Revenue Agency's Charities Information Sessions, Webinars and Webcasts

As the federal regulator of registered charities, the Charities Directorate of the Canada Revenue Agency provides information sessions to help registered charities understand their obligations under the *Income Tax Act*. The following media are available to charities:

- **Charities Information Sessions:** Face-to-face presentations across the country;
- **Webinars:** Live interactive presentations through the Internet; and
- **Webcasts:** Recordings of webinars for people to view any time they want.

All presentations are free, and are an excellent opportunity for any members of a charity to learn about various income tax provisions and obligations, which are often part of a charity's daily life (e.g., issuing receipts or filing the annual information return (T3010)).
