\*please note the fire danger rating may change throughout the day. Prior to burning find out the danger rating in your area.

<b>LOW</b>	<i>...Fires do not readily start and those that do start spread slowly and are easier to control.</i>
<b>MODERATE</b>	<i>...Forest fuels are drying and there is an increased risk of surface fires starting. Carry out any forest activities with caution.</i>
<b>HIGH</b>	<i>...Forest fuels are very dry and fire risk is serious. New fires may start easily, burn vigorously, and challenge fire suppression efforts. Caution must be used in any forest activities.</i>
<b>EXTREME</b>	<i>...Forest fuels are extremely dry and fire risk is very serious. Fires may start easily, spread rapidly, and challenge fire suppression efforts. Extreme caution must be used in any forest activities.</i>

**NEW FIRE ACTIVITY:** No new fires have been reported in the last 24 hours. Fire burning in the Tintina region remains 2748 hectares with no recent growth.

**CAMPFIRE AND BURNING RESTRICTIONS:** No campfire bans in place. Campfires are permitted outside of Whitehorse city limits. Public is reminded that burning permits are mandatory for any burning of brush, grass or debris. This also applies to burning with a burn barrel or lighting an open fire for any other purpose than a campfire. Permits are free and available at your local fire district or Energy Mines and Resources office depending on your region. **\*burning permits are suspended or no longer issued when danger rating is moderate, high or extreme**

**WEATHER FORECAST:** Showers and thundershowers are expected across the Klondike, Mayo, and Faro areas, as well as the Kluane district this afternoon. There is also a risk of showers in the northern sections of the Southern Lakes district, though lightning activity is expected to be minimal at this time. Brisk winds are expected to continue over the Old Crow and Rock River areas through the day, before beginning to die down this evening.
