VOLUNTEER FIRE EXPLORER PERMISSION FORM

FIRE DEPARTMENT: _____

This permission form is for those who are under the age of 18 and over the age of 16 and wish to be an active member in the Yukon Fire Service. These fire department members will be known as Fire Explorers.

- The minimum age for a Fire Explorer is 16 years.
- Each Fire Explorer must sign a Volunteer Registration Form.
- Each Fire Explorer must have this document signed by a parent/guardian prior to any training or issue of fire gear (PPE). This document must be sent to the Fire Marshal's Office.
- A Fire Explorer shall be safe at all times and may only be trained to the Yukon Fire Fighter Advanced Level.
- A Fire Explorer shall be supervised at all times.
- A Fire Explorer shall *never* be utilized in Immediately Dangerous to Life or Health (IDLH) atmosphere or dangerous incident situations.
- A Fire Explorer shall *never* drive any piece of fire apparatus.
- A Fire Explorer shall *never* perform duties or tasks he/she is not trained.
- A Fire Explorer shall receive honoraria.

Fire Explorer

1. When a fire fighter candidate (16 to 18 years of age) has successfully completed a Volunteer Registration Form, a Fire Explorer Permission Form, and is accepted for training by the Fire Chief, he/she will be known as a Fire Explorer.
2. A Fire Explorer shall work to successfully complete the Yukon Fire Fighter Basic fire training program. This level of training can be achieved during scheduled evening trainings/drills or scheduled weekend fire training.
 - a. When a Fire Explorer has successfully completed the Fire Fighter Basic fire training, he/she will be known as a Fire Explorer Basic (Basic Fire Explorer).
3. A Basic Fire Explorer shall work to successfully complete the Yukon Fire Fighter Advanced fire training program. This level of training can be achieved during scheduled evening trainings/drills or scheduled weekend fire training.
 - a. When Basic Fire Explorer has successfully completed the Fire Fighter Advanced fire training, he/she will be known as an Advanced Fire Explorer (Fire Explorer Advanced).
4. A Fire Explorer shall attend scheduled evening training/drills.
5. A Fire Explorer shall work to successfully complete the required First Aid Training.
6. A Basic or Advanced Fire Explorer shall work to successfully complete Wildland fire training
7. A Basic or Advanced Fire Explorer shall work to successfully complete all recommended training.
8. A Fire Explorer that meets all training requirements and is 17 years of age may be eligible for Stand-To.
